CAA Saskatchewan Announces Top Ten Worst Roads

Approximately 2800 votes were received from motorists in the CAA Saskatchewan 2013 Worst Roads Campaign scheduled from March 25 to April 25, 2013. And it's no surprise that Highway 123 near Cumberland House was voted as the province's number one worst road. Highway 123 has held the first place ranking consistently for the majority of the campaign period.

"The purpose of the campaign is to spotlight troublesome and even dangerous road conditions in the province and to address those roads in most need of attention with government authorities," said Christine Niemczyk, Director of Corporate Communications, CAA Saskatchewan.

A road qualifies as a "worst" if it is in general disrepair with potholes, cracks etc., has poor signage or congestion or is too narrow for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists to share safely.

The top 10 roads that received the most votes during the 2013 campaign are as follows:

1. Highway 123 near Cumberland House
2. Highway 42 near Dinsmore
3. Highway 908 near Ile a la Crosse
4. Highway 22 near Earl Grey
5. Pasture Road near Rosetown
6. Ring Road, Regina
7. Highway 18 near Beaubier
8. Highway 155 near La Loche
9. Highway 35 near Love
10. Highway 18 near Lake Alma

This list will be shared with the appropriate government departments. CAA Saskatchewan would like to thank all motorists and voters for helping to identify roads that are in need of repair. Working towards better roads and driving safety is a priority for CAA Saskatchewan.
