CAA Saskatchewan Announces Top Ten Worst Roads

A record breaking total of 4,651 votes were received from motorists in the CAA Saskatchewan 2014 Worst Roads Campaign scheduled from April 1 to April 25, 2014. In 2013, the CAA Worst Roads Campaign attracted 2800 votes and 2900 votes were tabulated in 2012.

Here is the list of the top 10 roads that received the most votes during the 2014 CAA Worst Roads Campaign:

1. Saskatchewan 24, Leoville
2. Saskatchewan 155, La Loche
3. Saskatchewan 21, Paradise Hill
4. Saskatchewan 44, Eston
5. Saskatchewan 51, Major
6. Northern Woods and Water Route, Carrot River
7. Saskatchewan 908 Île-à-la-Crosse
8. Saskatchewan 918, Patuanak
9. Saskatchewan 123, Cumberland House
10. Saskatchewan 51, Kerrobert

A road qualifies as a “worst” if it is in general disrepair with potholes, cracks, severe rutting, has poor signage or congestion or is too narrow for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists to share safely. “The purpose of the campaign is to spotlight troublesome and even dangerous road conditions in the province and to address those roads in most need of attention with government authorities,” said Christine Niemczyk, Director of Corporate Communications for CAA Saskatchewan.

The CAA Saskatchewan 2014 Top Ten List of Worst Roads will be shared with the appropriate government department. CAA Saskatchewan would like to thank all motorists and voters for helping to identify roads that are in need of repair.
