### 2018 CAA Worst Roads Campaign The Final Top Ten

The 2018 CAA Saskatchewan Worst Roads campaign has ended with some surprising results. A total of 1,782 votes were received during the campaign dates of April 16 to May 6, 2018. Nominated worst roads and votes continued to populate the website from road users across the province including drivers, cyclists, motorcyclists, and pedestrians. One vote per road per email every 24 hours was acceptable.

This year's campaign proved interesting with a mix of municipal streets and provincial highways finalizing the CAA Top Ten Worst Roads for 2018 which are as follows:

1. High Street West, Moose Jaw
2. Saskatchewan 47, Springside
3. Saskatchewan 350, Torquay
4. Academy Park Road, Regina
5. Saskota Flyway/Saskatchewan 9, Hudson Bay
6. Sidney Street, Maple Creek
7. 1 Avenue Southeast, Moose Jaw
8. Saskatchewan 18, Torquay
9. Saskatchewan 21, Paradise Hill
10. 9 Avenue Southwest, Moose Jaw

Worst roads are described as having cracks, crumbling pavement, potholes or craters, poor or no signage, traffic congestion, and lack of cycling or walking infrastructure. Christine Niemczyk, Director of Communications with CAA Saskatchewan, said: "Potholes and crumbling pavement remained as the number one problem identified by voters during the 2018 CAA Worst Roads campaign. We thank everyone who participated in this year's campaign."

The results of the CAA Top Ten Worst Roads for 2018 will be shared with the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure, the municipal councils in Maple Creek, Moose Jaw and Regina, as well as with the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities (SARM) and the Saskatchewan Urban Municipalities Association (SUMA).

Advocating for the safety for all types of road users is a priority for CAA Saskatchewan.
